Wernau – With the new Aqua 5000 S and Aqua 8000i S water softeners, users can enjoy all the benefits of soft water. More gentleness on skin and hair, reduced limescale on taps and an extended product lifecycle – the new water softeners from Bosch offer reliable protection for people and equipment.

Soft water saves money

The Aqua 5000 S and Aqua 8000iS water softening systems provide effective protection against limescale and corrosion. Once connected to the main water supply, they reliably filter out calcium and magnesium from the water and replace them with sodium. The result is noticeably softer water at all points of use. While users will clearly appreciate the greatly reduced effort required to clean surfaces and appliances, as well as the much greater bathing and showering comfort, household appliances also stand to benefit from the use of the Aqua devices, as they effectively prevent damage caused by limescale and corrosion and thus protect washing machines and kettles, for example, but also taps, shower walls and other surfaces. With less cleaning, a longer product life and a reduced consumption of detergent and dishwasher salt, the Aqua 5000 S and Aqua 8000i S offer considerable potential for cost and effort savings.

Quick and easy installation

With compact dimensions, the Aqua 5000 S and Aqua 8000i S water softeners fit into any home. Users can choose between 9, 14 and 18 litres, depending on their requirements. All devices in the series come with flexible connections and connection block as an accessory. This makes connection to the home's main water supply quick and easy.

Intuitive operation, smart connection

The new water softener series from Bosch ensures that the softening salt never runs out unnoticed, as the integrated salt level sensor reliably detects a low filling level. When the salt drops below a certain level, a flashing light alerts the user that the salt needs to be refilled. Refilling couldn't be easier: just open the flap and fill in the salt pellets. Thanks to the built-in salt grid, this is done quickly and without mess. On the digital side, the Aqua 5000 S and the Aqua 8000i S also impress with their simplicity: The self-explanatory touch HMI, for instance, allows users to adjust the water flow and select the regeneration mode. While the Aqua 5000 S requires an optional WiFi stick to go online, the Aqua 8000i S is internet-enabled by default. Both devices can be connected to the Bosch HomeCom Easy app for hassle-free remote control.

The Aqua 5000 S and Aqua 8000i S will be available from the third quarter of 2023.
